Why Colleges Plateau at A / A+

Good Intent, Weak Score Conversion

Strong institutional efforts fail to translate into proportional CGPA gains due to misalignment between activities and scoring metrics.

Documentation-Heavy Approach

Institutions focus on creating volumes of evidence without ensuring the quality, relevance, and clarity required by assessors.

DVV Objections Reduce CGPA

Data Verification and Validation challenges arise from inconsistent or unsubstantiated claims, directly impacting final scores.

NIRF Data Inaccuracies

Minor errors in parameter reporting compound across categories, pushing institutions into lower rank bands despite strong performance.

NIRF vs NAAC – How They Differ

NIRF is an annual ranking framework focused on comparative performance, outcomes, research impact and perception. NAAC is a periodic accreditation framework that evaluates institutional governance maturity, processes, documentation and continuous improvement.
